CLOSING THE BAG

- 1** Roll the mouth of the bag at least three times for a watertight seal. Then fasten the buckles on either side of the bag and pull the webbing ends to tighten the straps. After tightening, the excess webbing length can be folded and secured with the hook and loop strip at the end of the webbing.



- 2** If needed, use the air valve to release any extra air and further compress the bag.

- 3** (Optional) After the main mouth of the bag has been rolled closed, place the hypalon cover on top and attach it by weaving the webbing straps through the slots in the cover and fastening the plastic buckles.



- 4** Pull the loose webbing ends to tighten the straps. After tightening, the excess webbing length can be folded and secured with the elastic band.

ASSEMBLY TO THE MOTORCYCLE

- 1 Place the EVEREST Duffel Bag in the desired position on the rear rack or pillion seat of the motorcycle.

- 2 Locate 4 secure mounting points on the frame of the motorcycle, 2 on the front side of the bag and 2 on the rear side of the bag. Using the fixation strap included, pass the G-hook around the mounting point and through the loop on the other end of the strap. Pull tight to ensure the strap is securely attached.



- 3 For the most secure fitment, pass the G-hook through the slots on the front/back panels of the Duffel Bag, then hook the G-hook into the corresponding webbing loop above the slots. Pull the loose webbing end to tighten the straps. After tightening, the loose webbing end should be folded and secured with the elastic band.



- 4 Repeat steps 2-3 for the remaining straps. Ensure that all 4 straps are tightly secured, and the bag cannot move freely before each operation of the vehicle.



WEARING THE BACKPACK



Note: When wearing the backpack it's recommended to use the waist and chest straps to better distribute the weight of the load. Adjust the straps to a comfortable position, then tighten them as much as possible to reduce the pressure on the shoulders.



WARNINGS & GUIDELINES

WARNING!

Please read the user manual carefully and follow the recommended assembly method.

It's recommended to check that the bag is securely attached before each operation of the motorcycle.

Do not drive the motorcycle with a bag that is not fully closed, is not properly secured, or in any other condition that may affect the safe operation of the vehicle.

Ensure that no part of the bag, including the fixation straps or other accessories, has close contact with high temperature areas such as the exhaust pipe.

CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

To maintain a nice appearance, it's recommended to use silicone lubricant spray and a soft cloth to wipe the bags clean.

Do not use harsh cleaning agents, chemicals or high pressure cleaners.

When the surface material is exposed to direct sunlight for a long time or is affected by environmental factors (such as haze, acid rain, etc.), the color may fade or change.

If the product is contaminated with gasoline or similar substances it must be cleaned immediately!
